



The BASE Education Student Experience!

To gain access to the BASE student portal where you can participate in sessions and view course material you will need to go to course.base.education. Once on the landing page you will need to enter your unique username and password into the appropriate boxes and click on Log In. When you login for the first time (or for the first time each new school year), you will be required to complete the **Welcome Course** before you are able to access your assigned course material.
